Advent Course

The King James Bible is among the most significant publications ever produced in the English language. Its influence is massive and many of the best known and most loved sayings that we use every day find their origins in this version of the Bible.

The Lent Course that took place earlier this year was very popular and was based around sayings from the King James Bible.

This Advent Course is similar, drawing on well known phrases from the Christmas stories. Sessions will include reading from both the King James and modern Bibles and talking about how this story relates to our lives today

Sessions will take place on Mondays between 12.30 pm and 1.30 pm, at Central URC

Thursdays between 7 and 8 pm, at Bolton Road URC

Session 1 - 21st/24th November
“... and they shall call his name Emmanuel”
(Matthew 1.23)

Session 2 - 28th November/1st December
“And this shall be a sign unto you...”
(Luke 2.12)

Session 3 - 5th/8th December
“... they presented unto him gifts, gold, frankincense, and myrrh”
(Matthew 2.11)
